- "Bidder(s)" means a person or a person's agent who has completed proper registration with Maynards and has obtained a numbered bidding card (note that bidding cards cannot be shared between two or more bidders), who may place bids on property auctioned by Maynards; "Buyer's Premium" means a fee of not less than 15% of the Hammer Price, which will be added to the Hammer Price in respect of each lot purchased;
- (b)
- "Hammer Price" means the price at which a lot is Knocked Down to the Purchaser; (c)
- "Knock(ed) Down" means to conclude the sale of a lot by the auctioneer's call, inclusive of the blow or knock of the auctioneer's hammer; (d)
- "Purchase Price" means the aggregate of a) the Hammer Price; b) the Buyer's Premium and other surcharges, if any; and c) unless the Purchaser is exempt by law from the payment thereof, in accordance with article 6, the Sales Tax and any other applicable taxes or fees;
- (f) "Purchaser" means the highest Bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer as the Bidder who wins the lot: and
- "Sales Tax" means the Federal and Provincial sales and excise taxes applicable in BC or in the destination jurisdiction to which a lot will be delivered.
